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The Southern Regional Health Authority Story

A statutory body of the Ministry of Health & Wellness, the Southern Regional Health Authority (SRHA) delivers healthcare to more than 600,000 residents in the parishes of Manchester, Clarendon and St. Elizabeth. It is the second largest of the four Regional Health Authorities in Jamaica.

The Regional Health Authorities were formed in 1997 under the National Health Services Act, which was aimed at improving the management of healthcare facilities and bringing accountability to the local level. The Regional Health Authority is managed by a Board of Management, along with the Regional Director, who is responsible for the daily management of the region.

With a staff complement of more than 3900 employees, the SRHA administrates 74 health centres, five hospitals and one community hospital. The hospitals include the Mandeville Regional Hospital- Type B, the Percy Junor Hospital-Type C, the May Pen Hospital-Type C, the Lionel Town Hospital-Type C, the Black River Hospital-Type C and the Chapelton Community Hospital.
