PSYCHIATRIC NURSING AIDE (HSC/HS 5) - Males (2 Positions)

<u>Job Summary:</u>

Under the supervision of the Nurse in Charge, the incumbent will be responsible for providing basic patient care, including hygiene, preventive skincare, feeding, mobility, range of motion and application of safety measures to all mentally ill patients and their families in the hospital.

Qualifications and Experience:

- Completion of Secondary School with a minimum of two (2) 'O' Level/CXC subjects or equivalent, inclusive of English Language
- Certificate in Psychiatric Nursing Aide
- At least one (1) year experience

Required Knowledge, Skills & Competencies:

- General understanding of mental health and behavioural disorders
- Knowledge of skills in safe restraining techniques
- Display a high level of confidentiality
- Ability to understand verbal and written instructions, and to work under guidance
- Conforms to rules and regulations
- Good verbal communication skills
- Possess good customer service skills
- Excellent interpersonal relationship skills

Key responsibilities will include:

- Providing support in the mental health clinics by monitoring clients' activities during clinic sessions
- Assisting in maintaining clients' registers and entering relevant data on daily worksheets and other forms as assigned
- Assisting with conducting mental health education/promotional activities within the hospital.
- Providing support in emergency situations by assisting with care and physical restraint of clients who are at risks for injury to self and/or others
- Assisting patients with the removal of bedpans and urinals, observes and reports contents
- Accompanying patients from one location to another for treatment, tests, transfer and discharges as directed by nurse in charge
- Assisting in tidying and keeping patients' areas clean and properly ventilated, eg, bed-making, cleaning lockers

Special conditions associated with the job:

- May be required to work beyond normal working hours to include holidays and weekends.
- Working with patients who might exhibit violent/aggressive behavior.
