Job Summary

Under the direct supervision of the Public Health Inspector 3, the Entomological Assistant is essentially responsible for the prevention and control of vector-borne diseases through the timely detection and management of imported cases – in combination with the control of vector populations.

QUALIFICATIONS & EXPERIENCE:

- A minimum of four (4) subjects at CXC or GCE equivalent including Mathematics/Accounts, English, a science subject and one (1) other

- A minimum of three (3) years experience vector control

REQUIRED COMPETENCIES:

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES:

- ▲ Carry out investigations to determine whether persons with fever in risk areas may be suffering from malaria.
- ▲ Prepare blood smears in respect of persons who are suspected of having the malaria infection.
- ▲ Do systematic follow-up investigations of malaria-positive individuals.
