Job Summary

Reporting to the Maintenance Supervisor, the incumbent is responsible for performing highly skilled maintenance, installation, repair, and troubleshooting work involved with the hospital's electrical systems.

Qualification and Experience

- Diploma from a recognized accredited institution in Electrical Installation or any other area in Electrical Works
- A minimum of (2) years' experience in electrical installation
- Or
- National Vocational Qualification - level III certification in electrical installation (preferably from NCTVET), and three years' work experience in an acute hospital or large commercial/residential operation.
- Certification in boiler management and the operations and maintenance of generators would be an asset

Specific Knowledge and Required Skills

- Knowledge of Jamaica Building Electrical Codes and or codes of practice for Building Construction and infrastructure works
- Specialized knowledge to analyze and solve complex problems
- Thorough knowledge of electrical theory and methods, materials, tools, equipment, and systems
- Inspection of, identification, and knowledge of all electrical distribution systems (24-440 volts)

Key Responsibilities

- Install, service, and repair lighting fixtures, electrical panels, outlets and wiring.
- Repair electrical equipment or appliances by troubleshooting problems, replacing worn parts, switches, fuses, and rewiring electronic motors.
- Install conductors, splice cables, build terminations and does necessary hook-up for primary power lines.
- Install, repair, and service specialized electrical equipment and machinery following manufacturer's Instructions and safety precautions.
